

**INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS  
FOR  
WRITING THE MASTER ELECTRICIAN EXAMINATION**

1. 3 years has held
  - (i) Alberta electrician certificate of proficiency,
  - (ii) Provincial journeyman electrician certificate of proficiency issued by a province other than Alberta
  - (iii) Alberta restricted master electrician certificate and has been actively engaged in electrical contracting and upgraded his qualifications to an Alberta electrician certificate of proficiency.
2. Exams are written once a month.
3. Exams cannot be scheduled until the ECAA Provincial Office has received application and fee. Application and fee must be received about 2 weeks prior to date of exam.
4. A notification will be sent confirming date, location and time of exam.
5. The exam consists of 2 parts; Part I is a General Questionnaire and must be written in the morning commencing at 8:30; Part II is on the standards and regulations in the 19th edition of the Canadian Electrical Code and the Electrical STANDATA, and must be written in the afternoon commencing at 1:00. Each part of the exam is 3 1/2 hours long and must be written in 1 day.
6. To be successful in the examination, candidate must attain average of not less than 75% with a minimum of 60% in each part of Part I and Part II.
7. A person who fails to pass an examination is eligible to re-write a similar examination at the next scheduled exam sitting in the preferred area. Applicants receiving a 75% pass mark on any one Part may choose not to rewrite this portion of the exam, however must receive 75% on the part re-written to pass.
